The museum needs volunteers in three categories:

1. Museum Guide: on duty during Open Hours, Weds or Sat, 1-4 PM

Primary requirement: be welcoming and informative! You are the Museum's representative to the public. Duties: Open up and lock up; turn lights on and off; place "Museum Open" sign on tripod on first floor of library near elevator; place larger sign on stand outside museum door; greet visitors, ask them to sign guest register; offer membership information and newsletter; explain exhibits as needed. Remain in the main exhibit room and monitor visitors. (Guides cannot work in the back rooms during Open Hours; the door to the back rooms remains closed.) A key is available at the Library Circulation Desk to approved Guides, to be returned after locking up.

2. Technological Help

Experience with the *PastPerfect* museum database is ideal. We need assistance in entering our artifact accessions into this system from hand-written data entry sheets.

3. Exhibition Preparation and Installation

Work with staff to prepare mounts, write captions, paint cases, prepare list of new exhibit objects including catalogue numbers for files, and check condition of objects being returned from exhibit to storage. Replace returning objects in proper storage locations. Place Exhibit Report in files.
